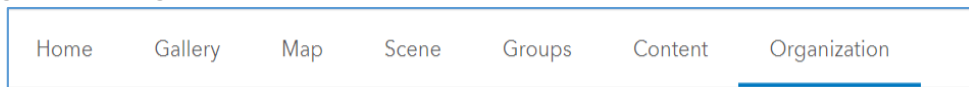


Configure a Geocode service in ArcGIS Online

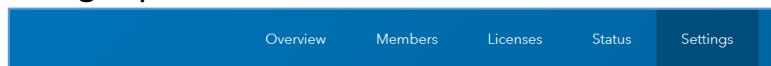
OSNI Locator webservices can be installed on Departmental ArcGIS Online (AGOL) and Enterprise Portals for use in Webmapping. To request the OSNI Address Locator and OSNI Fusion ID Locator for use in Departmental ArcGIS Online or Enterprise account fill in the [form](#) and log it through the [Contact Us](#) page

To configure a Spatial NI geocoding service in your organisational ArcGIS online account:

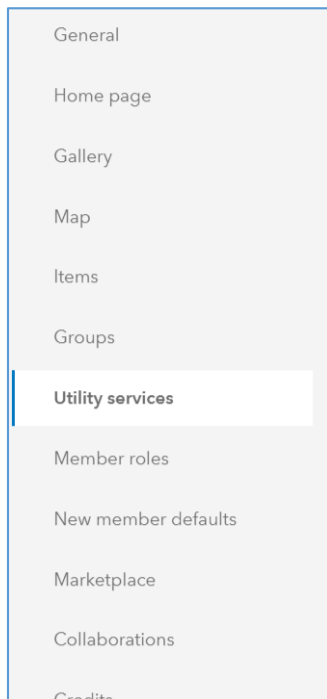
1. Log in to your organisational ArcGIS Online account (AGOL)
2. Navigate to Organisation tab



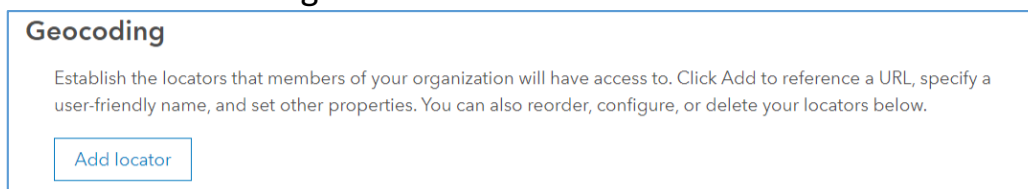
3. Select the Settings option



4. From the list, select Utility Services



5. Scroll to the Geocoding section and click Add Locator



6. From the dialog box that opens, configure the following options:

- Select the radio button beside New Locator
 - Select the radio button beside From URL
 - Enter the URL provided by Spatial NI (it will start with <https://utility.arcgis.com/>)
 - Give the locator a name (e.g. OSNI Pointer Address Locator)
- Configure the other options if required

7. Click Save

8. Your new locator should now appear in the list of Geocoding services

9. Remove the ESRI World Geocoding service if you just want the OSNI one available. If you had the previous OSNI Locator you can remove it as well. To do this click the three dots to the right of the locator you are deleting and select Delete from the dropdown
